



Threaded Rod Split Support

Threaded Rod Connector

Mount Plate

step 1

The threaded rod mounting system, with mount plates, is designed to attach to the bottom of a flat, non-sloped surface the runs above your proposed track. The threaded rod allows you to drop the curtain and track down below your flat surface (typically your ceiling) to bypass any obstructions to your track.

step 2

The mount plates need to be drilled into and attached to a flat, non-sloped surface



step 3

The threaded rod is to be attached to the plate via the threaded hole in the plate. There is no additional hardware needed for this, the rods should stay in place in the plate.

step 4

The threaded rod is designed to drop down and connect to your track at the other end (the end not occupied by the mount plate). Threaded rods come in standard lengths and may need to be cut in the field.
